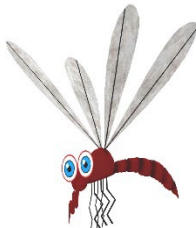
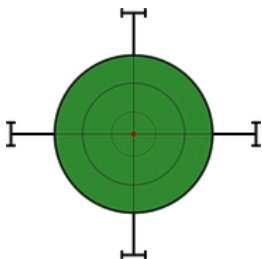

Join us to walk/run in honor, memory and support of everyone with memory loss and in celebration of all caregivers.

Almost all of us have a personal story about a family member or friend with memory loss, unfortunately few of those stories include ongoing support for the patient and their family.

While we all hope a cure is in the future, the focus of Countryside must be on today and what we can do to help make this journey a little easier.

With your support we are able to offer the following:

Free memory screens that can provide concrete suggestions to potentially help memory issues, provide a safe environment for patients and resources for their families.

A monthly meeting for caregivers – Memory Connection is held on the third Thursday of each month. This is an opportunity to ask questions, share experiences and information. All discussion is confidential.

Opening Minds Through Art (OMA) provides a social/art opportunity for those with memory loss and a brief time of respite for caregivers. This is a free program that meets weekly.

At the end of OMA sessions the artists are asked if they like their finished project, if it was time well spent and how they feel. One recent evaluation was very positive about the process, the artist felt their time was “absolutely” well spent and they felt “very happy”. Their volunteer also recorded the following quote:

**I haven't had this much fun in ages! I want to do this every day. I thoroughly enjoy this. This has really added to my life. I just can't wait to get here.**

One step at a time we can make a difference – see you on October 5<sup>th</sup>!

OMA – Thursdays 10:30 - 11:30 Opening Minds through Art (OMA) is a free program where individuals who have memory loss work side by side with a volunteer to create artwork. A full hour of creativity, conversation and laughter – if you have a loved one who would enjoy this experience or if you would like more information about becoming a volunteer call 945-0827.
